Category:Psychology books Angelos Konstantinidis Angelos Konstantinidis () is a Greek football manager and former player. He currently manages Omonia Aradippou. Playing career Konstantinidis spent a full decade of his playing career at Omonia. In that time, he amassed a record 502 appearances and made 248 appearances in first-team action. He won eight championships and four consecutive Super Cups with the club, as well as a Greek Cup final appearance in 1983. Coaching career After retiring from playing, Konstantinidis coached the youth teams of Omonia, retiring in 1995. He made one appearance at the helm of the first-team as a player, during the 1987–88 season. Since then, he has managed several clubs. Konstantinidis coached Aris, AEK Athens, Levadiakos, Kallithea and Panachaiki. His final managerial position was in the Cypriot Second Division with Apollon Limassol, with whom he finished in 16th place in 2007. In 2008, he coached Veria, Xanthi, Xanthi and PAOK, the last of which he managed to win the Championship. In 2009, he took charge of Ergotelis, before returning to Veria for the 2010–11 season. Konstantinidis left Veria in 2012 and joined Aris. He won promotion to the Super League that year. In 2013, Konstantinidis joined AEL Limassol and subsequently resigned in 2014. He took charge of Ionikos in early 2015. In the summer of 2015, Konstantinidis was hired by his former club Omonia. He began to work at the club in October 2015. with immediate effect. Powell,  
who was also chairman of Bury  
F.C. from March 2011 until

April 2015, has also been suspended from the Football Association, according to the Telegraph. Bury chief executive Chris Powell has stepped down after an investigation into alleged incidents of racial discrimination. The allegations centred around a post by one member on the social media site Twitter earlier this month. Writing on Twitter, the member alleged that Powell made

---

remarks about a picture of a young boy in a hoodie, saying the image could ‘get you killed’. Bury confirmed the allegations following the publication of the story, which can be read [here](#). The club subsequently launched an investigation and it is understood to have found evidence to support the allegations. Powell has since been suspended by the FA, who have announced that they will

---

be investigating the claims. Speaking about the situation on Friday, a club spokesman told the Telegraph: “Chris Powell has resigned as chief executive and a by-law enforcement officer of Bury F.C., a position which he held until he was suspended by the Football Association earlier this week. “It is right that Chris has voluntarily stepped down and he has made a donation of
